SOME GUIDELINES FOR LIFE AT SANDROYD

Rules:

All rules at Sandroyd are dictated by common sense and the need to look after each other as a community. Therefore:

- 1. Be kind
- 2. Look after your own possessions and do not ever touch other people's

Habits:

- 1. Aim to be tidy, polite and helpful to others
- Good manners cost nothing, but are so important. Aim to use 'Good mornings', 'Pleases', 'Thank yous' and smile whenever you can!
- 3. Try to help others who need your support and assistance

Expectations:

The Sandroyd Expectations are based around our motto – Niti est Nitere and will stand you in good stead for your time at Sandroyd and indeed beyond:

- · Challenge yourself
- · Respect each other
- · Be honest

What do these expectations mean?

Challenge yourself: Do everything to the best of your ability and look to step out of your comfort zone. Work hard to achieve your individual and collective goals.

Respect each other: Respect the individuality and interests of all pupils and staff. Uphold the values and morals that we stand for ensuring that you look after both yourself and your fellow pupils at Sandroyd.

Be honest: Be honest with adults, each other and also be honest with yourself. One of the best ways to learn from your mistakes is to understand and own up to making that mistake. This requires honesty and often courage.

Children's Policy and Code on Bullying

- Every child at Sandroyd, however big or small, old or young, has the right to be safe during their time here.
- No-one in the school will tolerate or allow unkind comments or actions, even when they are not intended to be hurtful.
- To stand by and watch when someone else is being bullied is to support bullying.
- Children should support and help each other by reporting to an adult any
 instances of unkindness or bullying they see or hear. If anyone sees anybody
 upset at any stage they should always report it to a member of staff immediately.
- · Bullying will always be investigated and taken seriously.

STAFF CONDUCT WHAT PUPILS SHOULD EXPECT

- It is essential that you feel safe and happy at Sandroyd. You should feel confident speaking to any staff member about any concerns or problems that you might have, and you can expect them to be kind and supportive in response and do what they can to help.
- 2. You will never be in trouble for raising a concern or worry and will always be listened to. However, please be aware that members of staff cannot promise to keep information to themselves as they are duty-bound to pass on any concerns to the appropriate person if they believe that you or someone else could be at risk of harm. This allows the proper support to be put in place.
- Your welfare is Sandroyd's highest priority. All staff have a duty of care to you. Any person working at Sandroyd must always maintain appropriate professional boundaries.
- You should always feel safe in the presence of any member of staff and adult; if you do not, then you should report it to another member of staff.
- 5. Members of staff must never use abusive language in any circumstances. You should always be treated with respect and dignity. No member of staff should ever humiliate or ridicule you, including on occasions when they may need to challenge you about your behaviour or performance.
- You must not go inside any member of staff's home. This includes your Houseparents' home.
- 7. Staff will not make physical contact with you unless they have sought your permission, and it is appropriate to do so (for example, when helping to demonstrate a task in sport or music). Any excessive or inappropriate physical contact that makes you feel uncomfortable should always be reported.
- Members of staff must not communicate with you on social media or contact you using a non Sandroyd email address. Equally, you must never contact members of staff using social media (or using a non-Sandroyd email address.)
- 9. If you ever have a worry, please talk to someone. Who you choose to speak to is up to you, and there is a notice in every classroom to help you make up your mind. Everyone is here to help, and if at any time you are feeling unsure, the golden rule is to talk to an adult. Alternatively please put a note in the concerns box.

- · Your Tutor or Class Teacher.
- · One of the GAPs.
- · If none of the above, why not ask one of your friends to help you?
- If you don't feel that there is anyone at Sandroyd who can help with your particular issue you could call Childline – freephone 0800 11 11 11.

Remember, there is always someone here you who you can talk to and who will listen and take your problem seriously.
